We still attend meetings regularly and stay involved in our fellowship. We will be married 5 years on October 22nd. We have an extremely loving and healthy relationship because we both do our best to practice the spiritual principles we have learned and continue to learn on this journey. We are living, breathing proof that miracles happen, and recovery is possible. The recovery community in Corbin is alive and thriving.
