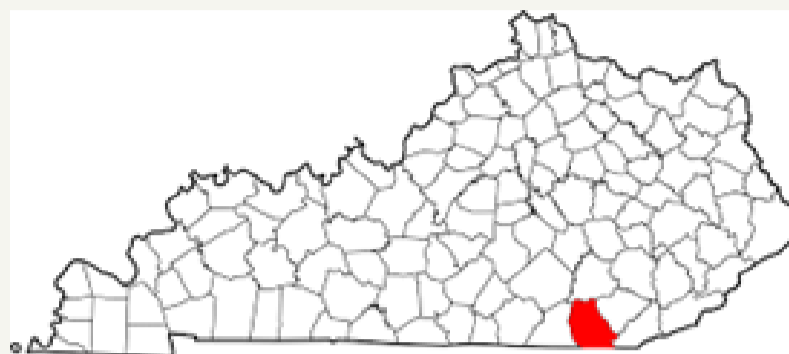




# The Whitley County Health Department Harm Reduction Program

Through Our Program **138,442** Used syringes have been collected Since the beginning of the program in 2017.

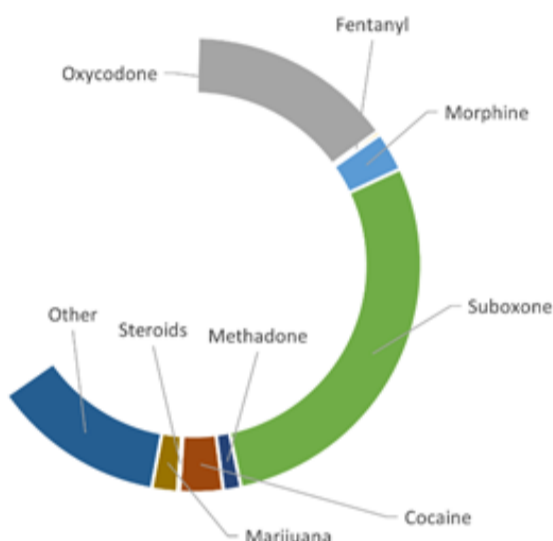
Our Program has:

Served **686** Unique Clients.

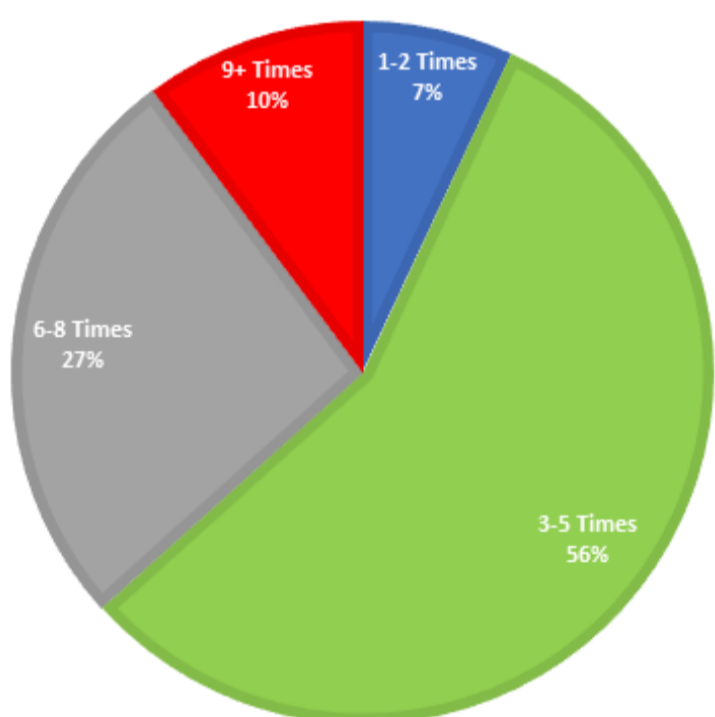
Administered **262** HIV/HEP C test

INJECTIONS PER DAY



**56%** of clients say they inject drugs 3-5 times per day

**27%** of clients say they inject drugs 6-8 times per day

**10%** of clients say they inject drugs 9+ times per day

**7%** of clients say they inject drugs 1-2 times per day

### Did You Know ?

According to the CDC, New users of syringe service programs, (SSPs) are five times as likely to enter drug treatment as those who don't use the programs.

According to the CDC, Nearly half of Kentucky's counties are at risk of an HIV outbreak. Whitley County is ranked 14th of 220 counties in the US at risk of an HIV outbreak

SSPs help people prevent transmitting bloodborne and other infections when they inject drugs.
